<p><b>Federal/State/Local/Tribal/Private Sector &amp; Nongovernmental personnel to include:</b></p> <p><i>Required:</i> Mid-level management including strike team leaders, task force leaders, unit leaders, division/group supervisors, branch directors, and; <i>Recommended:</i> Emergency operations center staff</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● ICS-100: Introduction to ICS or equivalent</li> <li>● ICS-200: Basic ICS or equivalent</li> <li>● ICS-300: Intermediate ICS or equivalent</li> <li>● <b>FEMA IS-700: NIMS, An Introduction</b></li> <li>● <b>FEMA IS-800.A: National Response Plan (NRP), An Introduction*</b></li> </ul>
<p><b>Federal/State/Local/Tribal/Private Sector &amp; Nongovernmental personnel to include:</b></p> <p><i>Required:</i> Command and general staff, select department heads with multi-agency coordination system responsibilities, area commanders, emergency managers, and; <i>Recommended:</i> Emergency operations center managers.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● ICS-100: Introduction to ICS or equivalent</li> <li>● ICS-200: Basic ICS or equivalent</li> <li>● ICS-300: Intermediate ICS or equivalent</li> <li>● ICS-400: Advanced ICS or equivalent</li> <li>● <b>FEMA IS-700: NIMS, An Introduction</b></li> <li>● <b>FEMA IS-800.A: National Response Plan (NRP), An Introduction*</b></li> </ul>

\* NOTE: Not all persons required to take ICS-300 and ICS-400 will need to take IS-800A Emergency managers or personnel whose primary responsibility is emergency management must complete this training.
